OBJECTIVE: The most unique characteristic of the Earth is the existence of life, and the most extraordinary characteristic of life is its diversity. Five decades ago, at the first Earth Summit, the vast majority of the world's nations declared that human actions were dismantling earth's ecosystems, eliminating genes, species, and biological traits at an alarming rate.

This observation led to a daunting question: how will biodiversity loss alter the functioning of ecosystems and their ability to provide society with the goods and services needed to thrive?

At present, this question remains unanswered in its entirety, adding other questions: how to channel our efforts for the conservation of biological diversity and a sustainable use of our ecosystems?

The Symposium aims to contribute to the knowledge, management and conservation of the diversity and functional capacity of ecosystems, promoting the exchange of knowledge, experiences, and establishing inter-institutional alliances. In addition, it pretends to promote strategies, both at the national and regional levels, to mitigate the underlying causes of biodiversity loss by actively involving governments and society in this effort and promote their sustainable use, guaranteeing fair and equitable access to the goods and services derived from their use.

Official languages: Spanish and English.

THEME:

- Species and ecosystems. Ecological, ecophysiological and biodiversity monitoring studies.
- Biological collections.
- Threats to biodiversity.

- Strategies and actions for the conservation and sustainable management of biodiversity for development.
- Landscape approach to biodiversity conservation and management (biological corridors, connectivity).
- Ecosystem restoration. Bioremediation. Biodiversity goods and services: traditional and alternative uses.

Guidelines for the presentation and publication of papers

Abstracts will be uploaded to the symposium website during registration, in Word format, in single paragraph with no more than 250 words, excluding title, authors and affiliation.

Title: In bold letters

- Authors: name and surname, underline the author who presents the paper, refer email of the presenter and the affiliation of all authors with a superscript number after the name and describe each author institution below.
- Structure of the summary: background, objectives, results and conclusions.

For more information on the characteristics of the abstract check the convention's website.

The review of the abstracts will be carried out by the Scientific Committee of the Symposium, which will decide its acceptance and modality of presentation: oral or poster.

The selected abstracts may be published in the peer reviews Cuban Journal of Biological Sciences, the Journal of the National Botanical Garden or the Journal of Marine Research, according to the themes of the event and following the author guidelines of each journal.
