Second Symposium "Social Sciences in Context: Contributions from the Latin

American Faculty of Social Sciences"

Havana, May 28 and 29, 2025

The Latin American Faculty of Social Sciences (Flacso Cuba) of the University of Havana summons the Second Symposium "Social Sciences in Context: Contributions from the Latin American Faculty of Social Sciences", which will take place on May 28th and 29th, 2025 within the framework of the International Scientific Convention "Saber UH".

The main objectives of this event will be to discuss the contributions of Flacso Cuba in the creation and strengthening of capacities for climate change adaptation, the implementation of Environmental and Social Safeguards, the mainstreaming of gender perspective and inclusion, as well as methodological proposals and tools that have strengthened the implementation of projects.

Likewise, the event aims to discuss associativity and cooperativism in the Caribbean and Latin American region in relation to rural development; popular and solidarity economy; science, technology and innovation for sustainable development; gender issues and rural women, as well as the hegemony of capital, imperialism and regionalization in contemporary government agendas.

Thematic Areas:

 Agriculture, cooperativism, and rural development: Cuba, Latin America, and the Caribbean. Adaptation to climate change in coastal areas. Methodological approaches from the Social Sciences.

- Exchange of experiences

Presentation and Publication Guidelines:

- Abstracts will be uploaded to the event's website during registration, in Word format, in a single paragraph with no more than 250 words, excluding title and affiliation.
- Title in bold letters
- Authors: first and last name, underline the author presenting the paper, provide
 the presenter's email, ORCID code, the affiliation of all authors with a
 superscript number after the name, and list each institution of origin below.
- Abstract structure: background, objectives, results, and conclusions.

The review of the papers will be carried out by the Scientific Committee, which will decide on their acceptance and presentation format: oral, poster, or online.

Selected works may be published in the journals of the University of Havana following their guidelines.
