Contemporary experiences and good practices”, which will be held between November 19 and 22, 2024 at the Enrique José Varona Convention Center of the University of Havana, Cuba.

Confirmation consists of accessing the Symposium Platform through the link <https://eventos.uh.cu/event/142/> and properly register by providing the requested data and then send (upload) a summary of the work you intend to present. The summary must have a maximum length of 250 words, written in Spanish using Arial Narrow font size 12, on an A4 format sheet, with single spacing and justified text with 2.5 cm margins on all sides. It will be headed by the title of the work in Spanish with bold capital letters. Below the title, the name(s) and surname(s) of the author(s) should be inserted, if applicable, as well as their institutional affiliations, postal addresses and emails. The content must state the topic investigated, the objectives, the methodology used, the results obtained and the main conclusions, in a single paragraph and without including quotes, abbreviations or acronyms. Below the text, insert up to 5 keywords in the same language and one line below, specify the thematic table in which you wish to intervene



and the way in which you wish to do so (in-person or virtual). The delivery (shipping) period will be until July 30, 2024.

The 3rd International Seminar will be developed based on the analysis and discussion of the works presented in thematic tables:

- Table 1. Theory and practice of building resilience in communities with vulnerabilities
- Table 2. Theory and practice of building resilience in natural ecosystems
- Table 3. Theory and practice of building resilience on a social, cultural and economic scale
- Table 4. Theory and practice of building resilience based on Adaptation to Climate Change (ACC) and Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) as its axes.
- Table 5. Contemporary manifestations in the construction of resilience in any area of society.
- Table 6. Currents of thought on building resilience in the world.
- Table 7. Presentation of the Global Network of academics, researchers and professionals for South-South and North-South cooperation on Resilience in Communities with Vulnerabilities.

The Scientific Committee of the event will review the abstracts and those that meet the requirements of writing, content and scientific relevance will be selected to be presented as a contribution to the seminar. This decision will be communicated in the first fortnight of September of the current year.
