- Table 5. Contemporary manifestations in the construction of resilience in any area of society.
- Table 6. Currents of thought on building resilience in the world.
- Table 7. Presentation of the Global Network of Academics, Researchers and Professionals for South-South and North-South cooperation on Community Resilience".
