









The Chair of Inter-Disciplinary African Studies "Amilcar Cabral", as part of the Faculty of Philosophy, History and Sociology, calls for the Workshop "Crossed views" (Miradas cruzadas), on the 60th Anniversary of the foundation of the African Union, within the framework of the International Scientific Convention "Universidad de La Habana 2023", to be held between May 29th to June 2nd. "Crossed views" will be in session from May 30th to June 1st.

On May 25, 2023, it will be the 60th Anniversary of the foundation of the African Union, the pioneer organization for the integration processes and struggles in favor of the de-colonization of African countries. The historical links between Cuba and the African continent are a strong support for the summoning of an

academic workshop, promoting exchanges between professors, academics, researchers, and students from Cuba and abroad.

General subjects will be:

- Regional and continental integration. Challenges, limitations and accomplishments. The 2063 Agenda.
- Africa at the world geopolitics.
- Political History of Africa.
- Contemporary African Thinking.
- Post-colonial African dynamics.
- Women in the anti-colonial stuggle and for African integration.
- Africa in the Caribbean imaginary.
- Visual expressions and tools they provide to deconstruct stereotypes about Afro-descent in Cuba.

Authors: name and surname, underline the author presenting the paper, refer to the presenter's e-mail address and the affiliation of all authors with superscript number after the name and include each institution of origin below.
Structure of the abstract: background, objectives, results, and conclusions.

Papers will be examined by the Scientific Committee of each event, which will decide on their acceptance and mode of presentation: oral or poster.
