IV Conference of Studies on United States and Hemispheric Processes

“200 Years of the Monroe Doctrine”

The Center for Hemispheric and United States Studies (CEHSEU) invites academics, researchers and students to the IV Conference of Studies on United States and Hemispheric Processes. The conference will take place from the 31st of May to the 2nd of June, 2023, in Havana, within the framework of the International Scientific Convention “Saber UH 2023”, organized by the University of Havana. The 2023 edition will be entitled “200 Years of the Monroe Doctrine”.

The papers presented should address phenomena related to United States´ reality: politics, foreign policy, elections, sociodemographic developments, ideologies, economic processes. Also, relevant hemispheric processes: conflicts, regional and subregional integration, regional security, national and regional political processes, inter-American relations, insertion in global processes, relations with extra-regional actors.

The main thematic lines are:

- 1.- United States: socio-economic evolution and political processes in the 21st century.
- 2.- United States: continuity and change in the factors and conditions of its external projection.

3.- US-Cuba relations.

4.- Latin American and the Caribbean: social, political and economic processes.

5.- Inter-American relations.

6.- The Americas in global processes.

7.- The Monroe Doctrine: historic role and impact on prior and current regional processes.
