 - Ethics, its structure, significant currents and thought studies from yesterday to today.
 - o Applied ethics and its contemporary significance.
 - Bioethics and epistemology. Main challenges in the 21st century.
 - o Latin American Ethics of the Caribbean, Cuban and Latin.

2. Seminar "Marxist Dialogues"

 Conceived as a space for the presentation and debate of research carried out from and on Marxism, understood as a complex totality of knowledge and praxis. The renovating studies on the past and history of Marxism are of interest, as well as its current projections, both in its perspective of thought and political activism. Other edges to attend would be:

- Study of works and Marxists; Marxism and institutional teaching; Marxism and feminism; cultural and scientific metabolism between Marxism and other theories; Marxism and socialism; Marxism and the historical present, Cuba and Latin America..
- 3. Scientific workshop "Philosophy through its research"
 - A space for presenting research projects, partial and final results, and contributions from completed research. Philosophical research in its various manifestations constitutes the general scope of this space.
 Among its main lines are:
 - History of philosophical thought, ontology, epistemology and philosophy applied to various human fields (philosophy of mind, politics and social, science and technology; ethics, bioethics and philosophical anthropology).

- Abstracts will be uploaded to the event website during registration, in Word format, title in bold, single paragraph 250 words or less (excluding title and affiliation)
- The following information will be required: authors (name and surname), underlining the author presenting the work, email address of the presenter, and affiliation of all the authors, with a number in superscript after the name and accompanied by the name of the institution of origin in the bottom.
- Structure of the abstract: background, objectives, results and conclusions.
- The review and acceptance of the works will be carried out by the Academic Committee.
