The following types of papers are invited:

- Full papers (12 pages) reporting on completed research.
- Short papers (6 pages) presenting ongoing or preliminary research.
- Posters (3-4 pages).

Papers must be original and not have been presented, previously published or under evaluation, in other events or scientific journals. All contributions will be evaluated based on their relevance, originality, importance and clarity following a double-blind peer review process. Authors of accepted papers must register for the Symposium and present their work during the Symposium.
